\$10,000 to the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program of Warren and Washington Counties (RSVP) to partially fund the expansion of the RSVP medical rides program in Southern Washington County

\$10,000 to the Greater Adirondack Home Aides to recruit, train and retain aides to build capacity and allow GAHA to serve additional clients in *Southern* Washington

\$20,000 to the Glens Falls Hospital Foundation to partially fund the purchase of diagnostic mammography equipment for the Greenwich Regional Medical Center

\$4,500 to the Glens Falls Hospital for the Hoosick Falls Family Health Center to purchase wireless internet services and equipment to further facilitate electronic medical record keeping.

\$3,000 to the Glens Falls Hospital for the Salem Family Health Center to purchase wireless internet services and equipment to further facilitate electronic medical record keeping.

\$18,500 to the Glens Falls Hospital for the Cambridge Family Health Center to purchase a stress test unit.

\$20,000 to the Cambridge Valley Rescue Squad to partially support the purchase of an ambulance; \$4,500 to implement an Emergency Medical Service Provider training course for EMS providers in the former McClellan Hospital foundation catchment area; and \$745 to study the feasibility of employing an electronic medical record system in regional ambulances.

\$20,000 Easton-Greenwich Rescue Squad to partially support purchase of an ambulance.

\$20,000 to the Salem Rescue Squad to purchase a defibrillator.
