2014 Grant Awards**

\$13,000 to the Cambridge Valley Rescue Squad (CVRS) for continued planning and development of the Mobile Integrated Health Care Program.

\$33,615 to the Cambridge Valley Rescue Squad to partially support the purchase: (1) an ambulance (\$20,000) and (2) two additional Ferno PowerFlexx Stretchers (\$13,615).

\$20,000 to the Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation at Hoosick Falls to partially support purchase of electronic medical records equipment, software, training and license fees.

\$10,000 to Community, Work and Independence, Inc. (CWI) to partially support purchase of lift/tilt/stand systems, medical equipment and specialized furniture for the Whipple City and Greenbridge Day Services sites located in Greenwich

\$9,150 to the Easton-Greenwich Rescue Squad to purchase three (3) new Panasonic Toughbook 19 EPCR units.

\$33,588 to the Glens Falls Hospital for the Diabetes Prevention Programs at the Cambridge Family Health Center, Greenwich Regional Medical Center, Hoosick Falls Family Health Center and Salem Family Health Center.

\$7,870 to the Glens Falls Hospital for partial support for the purchase of medical equipment, specifically a phlebotomy recline for each of the three family health centers in Cambridge, Hoosick Falls, and Salem as well as fluidotherapy equipment for the Greenwich Regional Medical Center.

\$11,000 to the Retired & Senior Volunteer Program of Warren and Washington Counties. The purpose of the funds is to partially support the medical transportation program in Southern Washington County.

\$18,277 to The Salem Rescue Squad, Inc. to purchase a Stryker Power Stretcher.
