Grant Award List 2012**

- \$16,581 to the Cambridge Family Health Center of Glens Falls Hospital to purchase a Piccolo Chemistry Analyzer
- \$12,745 to the Greenwich Regional Medical Center of the Glens Falls Hospital to purchase a new advanced Electrocardiogram
- \$5,515 to the Greenwich Regional Medical Center of the Glens Falls Hospital to purchase a new biofeedback unit and recliner to be used in the treatment of incontinence
- \$14,472 to the Hoosick Falls Family Health Center of Glens Falls Hospital purchase surgical light equipment and an illuminated magnifier to be used in minor procedures and two Brewer Access high-low power exam tables
- \$9,040 to the Salem Family Health Center of Glens Falls Hospital to purchase four integrated diagnostic systems and one portable diagnostic unit and an electronic wheelchair
- \$9,095 to the Cambridge Valley Rescue Squad to implement at least seven EMT Transition Courses (including one for the Hoosick Falls Squad) and at least one Advanced EMT Transition Course and purchase required manuals
- \$18,000 to the Cambridge Valley Rescue Squad to purchase a Type 2 (van style) ambulance—Mirage Ex Sprinter.
- \$20,000 to the Easton-Greenwich Rescue Squad for the purchase and installation of three Zoll X Series Monitors/Defibrillators in ambulances.
- \$19,292 to the Salem Rescue Squad for the purchase of a refurbished Zoll E Series AED, five Motorola Minitar V Pagers and four heavy duty flexible stretchers.
- \$15,000 to the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program of Warren and Washington Counties (RSVP) to fund the continual expansion of the RSVP medical rides program in Southern Washington County.
