Southern Adirondack Health Initiative

\$5,000 in funding toward the 2022 RAM Clinic at the Washington County Fairgrounds.

\$100,000 (over 5 years) awarded to a primary care doctor in Greenwich, NY to promote longevity and dedication to our community. This grant is included in the hiring package as college loan repayment.
